SHOULDER CORD AND PATCHES FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE WING CADET ACTIVITIES

CAPM 39-1, 26 JUNE 2014 is supplemented as follows:

1. In accordance with paragraph 9-3 the following shoulder cords are authorized for wear by New Hampshire Wing Cadets.

a. A red and white interwoven shoulder cord (Vanguard item #: 3740500 – Attachment is authorized to be worn by cadets that have graduated from or served as staff of the New Hampshire Wing NCO Leadership Academy (NCOLS). The shoulder cord will be worn in accordance with the requirements of CAPM 39-1. This shoulder cord is NOT authorized for wear by senior members.


2. Only one shoulder cord may be worn at any time. Shoulder cords specifically authorized by CAP regulation (CAC cords, Honor Guard cord, etc.) will take precedence over these cords and it is recommended they be worn by cadets that have earned them. These shoulder cords will be purchased at the member's expense.

3. In accordance with paragraph 10-7 the following patches are authorized for wear by New Hampshire Wing members.

a. The "New Hampshire/Vermont Wings Encampment Staff Patch" (Attachment 2) is authorized to be worn by cadets and senior members who have successfully completed a term of service as a member of staff at a NH/VT Wings Encampment. The patch will be worn centered on the left breast pocket of the BDU/BBDU uniform. One patch will be issued at the conclusion of the activity; members may purchase additional patches at their own expense.

b. The "New Hampshire Wing NCO Leadership School Patch" (Attachment 3) is authorized to be worn by cadets who have graduated from a New Hampshire NCOLS. The patch will be worn centered on the lower portion of the left breast pocket of the BDU/BBDU uniform. One patch will be issued at the conclusion of the activity; members may purchase additional patches at their own expense.

c. The "STAFF" patch (Attachment 4) is authorized to be worn by cadets and senior members who have successfully completed a term of service as a member of staff at a NH Wing NCOLS. The patch will be worn on top of, and resting on, the basic NCOLS patch. This combined patch will be worn centered on the lower portion of the left breast pocket of the BDU/BBDU uniform. One patch will be issued at the conclusion of the activity; members may purchase additional patches at their own expense.
